

Do you enjoy the Proven Winners plant quality? Then you too will enjoy this year's plant sale at the Sauk Prairie High School. The Introduction to Greenhouse Management class has beefed up its plant selection and brought you some of the highest quality plants for the lowest price.

Sauk Prairie High School agricultural students are getting a little taste of what it is like owning a business. Over the last semester, students involved in the Introduction to Greenhouse Management class have been tending plants and putting together potted arrangements. This operation has been made possible through the continuous support and efforts of the FFA Alumni and Sauk Prairie School District.

We believe that this operation of the greenhouse is giving the students the opportunity to understand how a business works. Over the last several months, we have received plugs and cuttings through an out of state business. From replanting to pinching to pruning, we have had a great time learning the ins and outs of maintaining healthy plants. This process has been very hands-on and we have learned a great deal from the tip of the roots to the tip of the flower. Almost everyday the class has gone out to the greenhouse to work with the plants and inspect each plant for possible diseases and key nutrient deficiencies.

The greenhouse management class has been growing **over 60** different varieties of plants since the beginning of the semester and they are now ready to be sold. The class has also compiled several hanging baskets to choose from as well as potted arrangements. Plant prices will be \$2.50 for a 4" pot, and \$2.50 for 3 and 4 packs. Hanging baskets will be \$15-\$20, plastic potted arrangements will be \$25-\$30, and wooded planter boxes will be \$30-\$35. The wooden boxes were a special project of the SkillsUSA club at Sauk Prairie High School. Please see our hours of operation and plant selection below.
